ACTION: Consider one application for funding from the Court Security Grant Program

AUTHORITY: 2014 HEA 41, Section 328
2015 HEA 56, Section 328

ALTERNATIVES: Approve or Deny Grant Request

BACKGROUND:

The Court Security Funding Program was authorized and funded with \$6 million during the 2014 Budget Session of the Wyoming Legislature (2014 Wyo. Sess. HEA 41, Section 328). The 2014 legislation created the Court Security Funding Program and authorized the State Loan and Investment Board (Board) to issue grants to Fremont and Sweetwater County only for court security improvements including the purchase of security equipment within courthouses or construction or modification of facilities. The 2014 legislation requires equal amount of matching funds from a non-state source for Fremont and Sweetwater County.

The Board was required to make their funding decisions for Fremont and Sweetwater County based on the following:

1. Imposition of local taxes;
2. Demonstration of previous financial commitment to court security initiatives;
3. Adaption of a complete operational plan for court security in accordance with court security commission standards;
4. Demonstration of need for facilities, including additional judicial resources as determined by the Supreme Court's Weighted Caseload studies; and,
5. Recent and serious security breaches or issues which cannot be adequately addressed by available county funds or resources.

During the 2015 General Session (see attachment), the Wyoming Legislature amended the program to increase funding by \$1,083,422 and authorize the Board to award additional court security grants for the following eight counties: Platte, Goshen, Niobrara, Albany, Big Horn, Crook, Park, and Weston (2015 Wyo. Sess. HEA 56, Section 328). The legislation for the additional eight counties removed the five requirements listed above and states no funding shall be awarded without matching funds provided by the county from any source. This legislation also details the amount available for each of the eight counties as well as the amount of match they must provide.

ANALYSIS:

Platte County submitted an application requesting \$21,414 in grant funding for their Improving Court Security at the Platte County Courthouse project. The improvements include:

- Converting 4 existing doors to Paxton Access control;
- Retrofitting 3 doors that currently do not have access control to the Paxton Access system; and
- Wire and increase network infrastructure and install all necessary lock components (see attachment 2).

The County was awarded a \$54,552 Courthouse Security grant at the February 4, 2016 SLIB meeting which was matched with \$9,381 from its general fund. Additionally, at the June 2, 2016 SLIB meeting the County was awarded a \$7,597 Courthouse Security grant. The match provided for the first grant is the total amount required by 2015 legislation; therefore no additional match is required. Total court security grant funds available to Platte County under the 2015 Wyo. Sess. HEA 56, Section 328 is \$84,429.

DIRECTOR'S RECOMMENDATION:

The Director recommends that the Board approve funding in the amount of \$21,414 for the Improving Court Security at the Platte County Courthouse project.

[COURT SECURITY FUNDING]

Section 328.

(e) There is appropriated from revenues deposited into the capital construction account funded by W.S. 9-4-601(a)(vi) and (b)(i)(A) and 39-14-801(e)(ix) one million eighty-three thousand four hundred twenty-two dollars (\$1,083,422.00) to an account within the state auditor's office under subsection (a) of this section to provide funding for court security improvements including the purchase of security equipment within courthouses or construction or modification of facilities containing a state court. Applications shall be submitted to the state loan and investment board which shall distribute the amounts to each applicant pursuant to paragraphs (i) through (viii) under this subsection:

(i) Eighty-four thousand four hundred twenty-nine dollars (\$84,429.00) to Platte county. No funding shall be awarded without matching funds provided by the county from any source in the amount of nine thousand three hundred eighty-one dollars (\$9,381.00);

(ii) Eighty-four thousand six hundred eighty-six dollars (\$84,686.00) to Goshen county. No funding shall be awarded without matching funds provided by the county from any source in the amount of nine thousand four hundred nine dollars (\$9,409.00);

(iii) Seventy-three thousand seven hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$73,778.00) to Niobrara county. No funding shall be awarded without matching funds provided by the county from any source in the amount of eight thousand one hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$8,197.00);

(iv) Ninety-five thousand three hundred fifty-five dollars (\$95,355.00) to Albany county. No funding shall be awarded without matching funds provided by the county from any

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source in the amount of ten thousand five hundred ninety-five dollars (\$10,595.00);

(v) Three hundred seventy-one thousand seven hundred ninety dollars (\$371,790.00) to Big Horn county. No funding shall be awarded without matching funds provided by the county from any source in the amount of forty-one thousand three hundred ten dollars (\$41,310.00);

(vi) Eighty-two thousand seven hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$82,778.00) to Crook county. No funding shall be awarded without matching funds provided by the county from any source in the amount of nine thousand one hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$9,197.00);

(vii) Eighty-two thousand seven hundred sixty dollars (\$82,760.00) to Park county. No funding shall be awarded without matching funds provided by the county from any source in the amount of eighty-two thousand seven hundred sixty dollars (\$82,760.00); and

(viii) Two hundred seven thousand eight hundred forty-six dollars (\$207,846.00) to Weston county. No funding shall be awarded without matching funds provided by the county from any source in the amount of twenty-three thousand ninety-four dollars (\$23,094.00).

(f) Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e) and 9-4-207, any unawarded and unobligated funds remaining from appropriations in this section, shall revert to the budget reserve account on June 30, 2018.
